General Information

Brief History of the Faculty of Health Sciences

The Faculty of Health Sciences was founded in 1975 with the aim of training highly accomplished, skilled, committed and open-minded professionals for the Hungarian health care. This was the first school in Hungary that trained dietitians, health visitors, physiotherapists, public health and epidemiology inspectors, vocational teachers and ambulance officers.

During the last years, both the structure and the curriculum have undergone changes in the spirit of modernization. As a result, there are at present 14 departments, about 200 highly-qualified lecturers and more than 3500 students.

It was an important event in the life of the Faculty that it became an integrated part of the famous and well-known Semmelweis University in 2000.

Facts and Figures

Since 1975 20 programs have been established and more than 22,000 students graduated from the Faculty. Today about 3500 students are studying at this institution. The Faculty is very proud of its Library with more than 50,000 volumes.

During the last four decades, the Faculty has developed extensive international relations, and as a result it established connections and part-

nerships with about 100 higher educational institutions throughout Europe, Asia and America. Since the beginning of the Erasmus/Socrates program more than one hundred students and dozens of staff members took part in long-term exchanges. The Faculty's Asian relations have also been largely extended by establishing a fruitful relationship with Shanghai Jiao Tong University School of Medicine (SJTU) and Heilongjiang University of Chinese Medicine (HLJUCM) in China. Consequently, HLJUCM launched their B.Sc. Traditional Chinese Medicine training at our Faculty in 2010. One of our strategic aims is to establish cooperation with Nguyen Tat Thanh College (NTT) in Vietnam in respect of launching B.Sc. Nursing program in the near future. We are also proud of having operated our B.Sc. Physiotherapy training in Lugano, Switzerland since 2009.

International and Hungarian Accreditation

From 2004 – with Hungary becoming a member state of the EU – all diplomas of the Faculty are accepted by the member states of the EU with supplementary exams if needed, and what is more, our graduates can also work in the United States and Canada after they have acquired sufficient proficiency of English and passed supplementary exams if needed.

Campus

Without an official address in Hungary, the Residence Permit cannot be obtained. Semmelweis University provides accommodation for its students in its well-equipped and comfortable dormitories. EFIT Foundation

The foundation was established by students of the Faculty in 1991 with the mission of developing educational and international relationships.

Aims and results:

Programs in English

Physiotherapy B.Sc. Program

Physiotherapists are independent practitioners as members of health care teams working in prevention, health promotion and rehabilitation. Physiotherapy education at Semmelweis University Faculty of Health Sciences prepares students to be autonomous practitioners who can perform functional examinations, identify impairments, functional limitations, abilities and disabilities by using clinical decision making process. They can plan, explain, carry out, and adapt an examination based treatment, draw conclusions from the examination as a whole and rank the main problems according to the priority.

In treatment, physiotherapists can work with the patients independently to define shared goals for the treatment, decide on, explain and use relevant methods of treatment, evaluate the effect of the physiotherapy treatment in relation to the set goals, adapt and modify the method of the treatment to suit the individual patients, evaluate and modify manual skills, work out an account of the patient prognosis, document examination findings and treatment processes correctly, communicate with other health care professionals.

The program combines theory and practice in order to support students to integrate theoretical knowledge into practice.

Entrance requirements: applicants must successfully complete a language test in English and conduct a personal interview

Major curricular components: Social and Behavioral Sciences, Basic Sciences (Anatomy, Physiology and Pathophysiology), Basic Professional Sciences (Functional Analysis of Musculoskeletal System, Biomechanics), Physiotherapy Methods (Manual Techniques, Electrotherapy, Therapeutic Exercise, Training Methodology), Clinical Sciences and Applied Physiotherapy (Cardiorespiratory, Musculoskeletal and Neurological Physiotherapy), Physiotherapy for Specific Populations (Pediatrics, Elderly Care, Women Health, Critical Care), Clinical Practice in Different Fields of Health Care.

Career opportunities: Hospitals, Clinics, Out-patient Clinics, Rehabilitation Centers, Adult Care Institutions, Primary Care, Home-Based Care, Schools, Hospice Care, Workplace Health Centers, Medical Tourism (Wellness Hotels, Thermal Baths, Spas), NGO Regional Community Wellness Programs, Sports Centers, Professional Sport Teams. After completing this program students can go on with their studies to the M.Sc. Program.

Physiotherapy M.Sc. Program

Semmelweis University Faculty of Health Sciences provides a new intensive master program for physiotherapists. The aim of Physiotherapy M.Sc. program is to prepare students for professional research and excellence in clinical practice. In order to reach this goal, the program focuses on a strong scientific foundation and encourages the development of practical and clinical reasoning skills of physiotherapists in order to treat patients effectively and safely. The program emphasises the

critical evaluation of effectiveness of physiotherapy interventions, based on knowledge of research methodology. Academic teachers use a variety of teaching and learning methods. The course includes lectures, tutorials, practical sessions and computer based learning. Clinical education is an integral component of the program. Clinical courses integrate the core practice areas of cardiorespiratory, neurology, and musculoskeletal.

Minimum of enlisted applicants: 10

Length of studies: 3 semesters, 90 credits

Degree: M.Sc. in Physiotherapy

Entrance requirements: applicants are required to have a Bachelor degree in Physiotherapy and they have to complete a theoretical written exam of professional knowledge.

Major curricular components: *Foundation of scientific research:* Advanced Biophysics and Biomechanics, Scientific Research Methodology, Neurophysiology, Clinical Exercise Physiology, Motor Learning and Neuroplasticity, Science of Nutrition, Pedagogy and Clinical Psychology; *Social Sciences:* Quality Assurance in Health Care, Leadership and Management in Health Care Institutions; *Foundation of Sciences:* Clinical Science in Musculoskeletal, Neurology and Cardiorespiratory, Developmental Neurology, Pharmacology, Image Techniques in Physiotherapy Practice, Clinical Neuropsychiatry; *Professional Sciences:* Differential Diagnosis in Physiotherapy, Scientific Background and Evidence Based Practice in Manual Therapy, Active techniques, Neuromuscular Techniques, Coordination and Proprioception, Exercise Prescription in Rehabilitation.

Career opportunities: in a variety of healthcare settings including hospitals, rehabilitation and community health centres, private practice, indus-

trial clinics and specialist facilities. Qualified master physiotherapists may also work in education as a clinical supervisor and researcher.

Nursing B.Sc. Program

Nurses are professionals who can individually organize, manage and supervise the whole process of nursing in every area of health care. Nurses holding a B.Sc. degree can organize, manage and supervise all their internal medical, surgical, obstetric-gynecological, psychiatric, intensive nursing and primary care tasks in every area of health care. They are responsible for conducting the healing-nursing activity prescribed by the physicians, and help the patient and the physician in performing certain examinations.

Length of studies: 8 semesters, 240 credits

Degree: B.Sc.

Entrance requirements: applicants must successfully complete a language test in English, and conduct a personal interview.

Major curricular components: Social and Behavioral Sciences, Basic Sciences (Anatomy, Physiology and Pathophysiology), Basics of Nursing, Nursing Ethics, Internal Medicine and Nursing, Surgery and Nursing, Obstetrics-Gynecology and Nursing, Anesthesiology-Intensive Therapy and Nursing, Pediatrics and Nursing, Neurology and Nursing, Psychiatry and Nursing, Primary Health Care and Community Nursing, Oncology and Nursing, Case Studies in Simulation.

Career opportunities: Primary Care, Specialized Care (Hospitals, Clinics, Nursing Homes, Hospice Care).

Nursing M.Sc. Program

Graduates of the B.Sc. Nursing program can go on with their studies in the master program. The M.Sc. program aims at training professionals who grasp the operation of the domestic health care system and the developmental opportunities concerning society, who participate in solving the scientific problems of nursing. M.Sc. graduates can conduct research projects in their professional field and initiate the adaptation of findings into practice. Completing the master program, nurses are able to work independently, define problems, priorities and goals concerning public health, and fulfill tasks of resource management. Graduated master nurses can continue their studies in the Ph.D. program.

Length of studies: 3 semesters, 90 credits

Degree: M.Sc.

Entrance requirements: applicants must successfully complete a language test in English and conduct a personal interview.

ing, Current Clinical and Pharmacological Knowledge, Applied Genetics, Nursing Management – Clinical Leadership in Practice, Nursing Education in Practice.

Midwifery B.Sc. Program

Midwives are professional who are supporting women and their families before conception, ante- and postnatally, including family planning. Their responsibilities are to monitor pregnancies, labours and postpartum progress while cooperating with other healthcare professionals to achieve the best possible outcomes for each individual family.

Minimum of enlisted applicants: 10

Length of studies: 8 semesters, 240 credits

Degree: B.Sc.

Entrance requirements: applicants must successfully complete a language test in English, and conduct a personal interview.

Major curricular components: Basics of Nursing, Internal Medicine and Nursing, Surgery and Nursing, Case Studies in Simulation, Midwifery Ethics, Neonatal-Pediatrics and Nursing, Obstetrics-Gynecology and Nursing, Home Delivery, Special Outpatient Unit, Delivery Room, Newborn Baby Unit – Rooming-in, Practice of Health Visitors, Neonatal Intensive Care.

Career opportunities: Obstetrics-Gynecology Department/Delivery Room, Special Outpatient Department, Prenatal Care, Postpartum Care, Lactation Consultant, Family Planning.

Information about the B.Sc., M.Sc. and Ph.D. Programs

Hungary, as a member of the European Union, belongs to the unified European Higher Education Area, which in principal follows the British and American three-cycle (bachelor, master and doctorate) training system.

In order to meet the objectives set in the Bologna Declaration, Semmelweis University Faculty of Health Sciences restructured its training system. Programs leading to a Bachelor's Degree are based on a one-year core curriculum, followed by three years of study in specialist programs (major).

B.Sc. programs require the completion of 240 ECTS credits.

M.Sc. programs require the completion of 90 ECTS credits.

The qualifications are comparable and recognized all around Europe. In this system it is much easier for students, lecturers and researchers to travel and build international relations, moreover, as citizens of the European Union they can continue their studies and plan their future as employees or entrepreneurs in any of the member states.

The training experience of long years and the valuable assets of the Faculty of Health Sciences have been incorporated in the new system. Qualifications are defined in terms of learning outcomes and not in the length of years.

Application and Admission Requirements

General Requirements

The Faculty of Health Sciences seeks students with appropriate academic qualifications, good command of English, and strong motivation to study and practice health care professions. Letters of recommendation are welcomed.

Application Requirements

Application Form and all supporting documents have to be presented **until July 29, 2016** to the officially appointed Semmelweis representative in the applicant's country (see the list of Representatives at <http://www.studyhungary.hu>), or to College International Budapest (H-1406 Budapest 76, P.O. Box 51, Hungary), or directly to Semmelweis University Faculty of Health Sciences (H-1088 Budapest, Vas u. 17., Hungary; to the Foreign Students Secretariat). Admission period: till July 29, 2016.

Documents to submit for B.Sc. application

1. **Completed Application Form** (attached page of the brochure or downloadable from <http://www.studyhungary.hu/pages.php?pageID=33>)

2. **Payment Certificate about:**

- application fee of EUR 200 (non-refundable) payable to the local representative. If there is no local representative, please transfer the fee to the bank account of IS International Studies.
- test fee (non-refundable) EUR 250 if the test is taken in Budapest.

3. **Secondary School Leaving Certificate** from an accredited secondary school. This document is a necessary prerequisite of starting the studies (original/attested copy + copy). If the student at the time of applying has not completed his/her studies at secondary school yet, the leaving certificate can be submitted until the registration day.

Transfer from other Universities

Students who have successfully pursued studies at other accredited universities (in Hungary or abroad) can apply for admission without being obliged to take an entrance examination. Subjects of previous studies with identical or at least 75% similar content to the subjects included in the curriculum of Semmelweis University Faculty of Health Sciences can be accredited, meaning that admission to an upper year might be possible.

Transfer students are required to prove their **current student status** and **previous study results**. The previous study results will be examined by Semmelweis Credit Transfer Committee. On the basis of this examination it will be decided how many of the previously completed subjects get accredited, and in which year the applicant can start his/her studies.

Required documents for Transfer to the Faculty

1. Completed transfer request form: indicating the student's intentions about the transfer (form is downloadable from <http://www.studyhungary.hu/pages.php?pageID=33>)

2. Official Transcript/Academic record: including all the grades and credits from the previous college/university studies (original/attested copy)

3. Student status certification: from the current university (issued not more than 30 days prior to the request's submission, indicating the currently active/passive student status)

Please note that we need:

- the original English document OR

- the attested copy of the original English document OR
- the authorized English translation of the original non-English document.

Further documents required for Credit Transfer

In case the applicant would like to turn in a Credit Transfer Request to get his/her earlier studies (credit points) accredited, it is necessary to present the following documents:

- official Subject Descriptions
- completed credit transfer request form for each and every target subject (form is downloadable from <http://www.studyhungary.hu/pages.php?pageID=33>)
- official certification about the field practices
- marking scale in order to evaluate/compare academic records accurately

Further information about the credit transfer request will be provided at the Foreign Student Secretariat after a successful enrollment.

Deadlines

- for turning in transfer and/or credit transfer request to the Faculty: latest till July 3, 2016.

Aptitude Test

Aptitude tests are held continuously either in Budapest or in several countries of the world (please see <http://www.studyhungary.hu>). Applicants will be informed about the place and date of the aptitude test by the Faculty or by the official representative.

The **evaluation** of the aptitude tests will be performed by the Faculty Board. Applicants will be notified about the results within three weeks after the tests.

Student Visa

Students coming from EU and EEA countries and holders of passports issued by countries that granted visa-free travel to Hungary under bilateral agreements (<http://konzulizsolgalat.kormany.hu/visa-waiver-agreements>) do not need a student visa, but have to apply for a registration card within 90 days after their arrival.

The accepted non-EU students have to apply for a student visa. The requirements will be listed in the Acceptance Letter issued by the Faculty.

Fees and Costs

Tuition Fee and Additional Charges

The yearly tuition fee is to be paid in two installments by semesters until the deadlines given below, unless the Hungarian Visa regulations prescribe different conditions.

Personal checks and money orders are not accepted.

Please note that the above mentioned net amounts have to arrive to the account – the commission charges have to be paid by the student.

Important: If the tuition fee is not credited to our bank account by the above deadlines, students may be suspended/dismissed.

Refund Policy

1. Before registration at the Faculty

Non-refundable: Application fee (EUR 200) and Exam fee (EUR 250 in Budapest)

2. After registration at the Faculty

Non-refundable: Registration fee (EUR 220), Application fee (EUR 200) and Exam fee

Refund of the tuition fee is regulated by the Regulations of Semmelweis University Faculty of Health Sciences and indicated in the study agreement.

No other claims are acceptable.

Other Costs

Health Insurance

A full coverage basic health insurance for Hungary is a **prerequisite for registration** at the university.

As a part of the tuition fee, a special insurance for students is offered by the Union Insurance Co. which includes an English-language call center, GP-service and treatment at the Polyclinics and Clinics of Semmelweis University. You will find details in the letter of acceptance.

Field Practices

Students are required to have some medical examinations to start Field Practices. Students need to get these certificates themselves and for most of them they also have to pay.

Academic Policies

Academic Policies

Students are required to know and act according to the Faculty's **Studies and Examinations Regulations**. Attendance at classes and practical exercises are prescribed in the current Subject Descriptions.

Students are expected to take examinations when scheduled, otherwise they lose their chances. The credit-system allows a certain degree of flexibility in signing up for courses and in the timing of exams.

This is conform to international standards and helps an easier setting-in of students with different educational backgrounds.

Students get more information about study matters at the Registration and in the course of "Introduction to Higher Education Studies".

Basics of the Credit-based System

A new credit system was introduced in September, 2003 to subserve free workflow in the EU, and to promote easy career adjustment in the framework of lifelong learning.

1. A credit point is a unit of measure of average total student coursework workload needed to complete a subject. A credit is earned if the student receives at least a pass mark (or a "satisfactory" mark) for a course. The value of the credit earned is independent of the mark received for the course.

No credit will be earned, if any of the policies are violated.

2. One credit is earned for every thirty hours of the student's academic work. This academic work includes the time spent in class and the time spent on individual work by the student.
3. Credits can be earned for courses that conclude with examinations.

For Accreditation Process

In case the applicant would like to submit a Credit Transfer request (credit points) to have the earlier studies admitted, please see the details on pages 10–11.

4. At the end of the four years of study, students have to write a thesis and pass a final exam. These are prerequisites of a diploma.

Pre-Medical Program, McDaniel College – Budapest Campus

The Pre-Medical Program of McDaniel Europe – The Budapest Campus of McDaniel College prepares students – who require additional instructions or review in sciences and in English language – to take the entrance examinations for the regular Degree Program.

With English as the language of instruction, the following subjects are covered: General English, Medical English, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Hungarian Language.

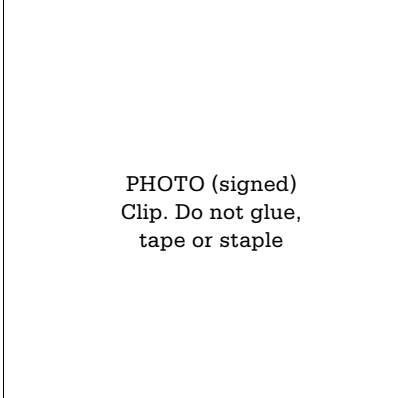
